### 2017 Bond Program – Issues and Risks

#### **January School Openings**

With the first three modernized elementary schools scheduled to open in January, CMD leadership has each been assigned a campus to monitor closely. This should enable us to identify and address any issues quickly, before they impact the campus opening.

#### **FF&E Procurement**

Furniture and equipment is being ordered for the first three modernized campuses, which will open in January. Construction Management is working closely with procurement to ensure that all items are ordered, delivered, and installed on time.

#### **Eastside Memorial ECHS Budget**

Due to high market conditions, we received an unfavorable bid on the Eastside Memorial Early College High School & International High School at the Original L.C. Anderson campus modernization, which came in 10% above the project construction budget (PCB).

The team – which includes the architect, general contractor and AISD staff – looked at several options, which resulted in a 5% reduction without affecting the promises made to voters.

### 2017 Bond Program – Issues and Risks

#### **Murchison MS - Construction Noise and Disruptions**

Construction noise and activities have caused some disruptions at Murchison MS since students returned from summer. The noise issue is primarily due to chipping rock for underground utilities and to excavate for grade beams. CMD explored installing insulation panels in the nearby school windows; however, Murchison Staff did not want to lose the natural light. The contractor is chipping for shorter durations and after normal school hours and on Saturdays to minimize disruption. The noise is being monitored to determine sound levels inside the school. At this time the noise is not hazardous but is a nuisance.

#### **Brentwood ES Modernization - Swing Space**

The Brentwood ES Modernization project was initially planned to take place in phases while the campus is occupied, similar to Casis ES or Govalle ES. Early in design, we are facing challenges that could impact this on site swing solution. CMD is investigating other options, including swinging all or some of the school to another location during construction. This could significantly shorten the overall construction duration, and potentially save cost due to escalation and general conditions. Once a path forward is determined, it will be shared with the community.

### 2017 Bond Program – Significant Changes

#### Rosedale Modernization: Change in Procurement Method

The Rosedale Modernization project was originally planned to be a design-build delivery, but has been modified to a Construction Manager at Risk (CMR) delivery. AISD Contract and Procurement canceled the initial design-build solicitation, and have opened a new solicitation for the CMR. Page Architecture was selected as the A/E, are under contract, and begin design this month.

### Norman ES Modernization: Change in Contractor and Schedule Delay

The Norman project has undergone some design changes and construction challenges that have led to a change in contractor and a schedule delay. AISD was unable to reach a negotiated agreement for the next phase of work with the previous contractor, and will be resoliciting for a new CMR to finish the project. We anticipate the new CMR recommendation going to the board for approval in October, and the project opening to students in January 2021.

### 2017 Bond Program – Significant Changes

### Lee Elementary: Schedule Delay

The new addition at Lee ES is experiencing a schedule delay. The site permit for the project has taken 4 months longer than anticipated, but we believe we have navigated a path forward.


### **Crockett HS: Scope Change**

Crockett HS staff have requested a dust collection system be installed in the Construction Technology Building. This was not originally part of the scope of the project, but because it is a safety concern CMD is exploring the possibility of adding the dust collection system with bond contingency as a safety related item.

#### **Baranoff ES: Budget Concerns**

CMD received five bids for the drainage improvements at Baranoff ES, and they came in over budget. This is the last phase of work, and we have sufficient remaining project contingency to cover the overage.
