BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Each year, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) rates all public school districts and campuses in the state on a series of performance measures. The District and Campus ratings are published in the AEIS reports released annually in the fall by TEA. State law requires each district to hold a public hearing and to disseminate the reports.

TEA has released the annual District AEIS 2009-10 documents, the public hearing will be conducted on January 24, 2011 and the required annual AEIS documents will be available at <u>http://.austinisd.org</u>. The full Annual District AEIS report will also be available at the main Austin Public Library and the Board of Trustees Library.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:

In 2009-10, Austin Independent School District attained the State's Academically Acceptable rating, 32 Austin ISD campuses achieved the Exemplary status, 36 campuses attained the Recognized status, 41 campuses received the Academically Acceptable status and one campus was rated Academically Unacceptable.

At the request of the DAC, following the presentation of the Annual District AEIS report, the DAC Co-Chairs would like to take this opportunity to briefly hear from Trustees recommendations on how the DAC might work over the coming months to help the district improve the performance and success of all students.
