Cleopatra Salomon, Burnet Middle School teacher, and Alvis Prince, CTE Advisory Co-chairs welcomed attendees to the evening meeting. Thanking everyone for taking the time to attend. Cleopatra introduced Gerardo Gandy of ACE Mentor Program to talk about his program during Citizens Communications.

Gerardo talked about the 2017 final program – MEGA: A Tall Building for the 21st Century. Teachers interested in getting involved in the project were informed to contact Gerardo.

Following introductions of the 46 attendees Annette Gregory provided an update on 2016-17 CTE initiatives.

Beginning with the CTE Mission, Annette talked about the strength of the CTE programs:

- A total of 21,655 students are currently enrolled in CTE pathways
 - o 13,566 High School students
 - o 8,089 Middle School students
- She discussed the enrollment growth from 2015 to 2016 and noted the increased career cluster growth highlighted in PEIMS Report for the following clusters:
 - Agriculture, Food & Natural Resources
 - Architecture & Construction
 - o Arts, A/V Technology & Communication
 - Business, Management & Administration
 - o Human Services
 - o Law, Public Safety, Corrections & Security, &
 - o STEM
- Annette talked about how the district defines "Career Ready" and explained that our goal is to ensure that students graduate with:
 - o Academic Skills
 - Employability Skills &
 - Technical Skills
- She reminded the group that February is CTE month and to check the AISD website for CTE promotions featuring students in various pathways.
- Annette ended her remarks by reminding the group of her retirement and that her last day at AISD would be January 31st and it's "never Goodbye...but, See You Later"!
