\*FMP – Facility Master Plan - The Board Approved 2016-17 FMP Update is a high-level guideline for all of the District's facilities over the next 25 years. Its intent is to document the current status of each of AISD's buildings, identify a vision for their future, and chart a path to achieve that vision by identifying the level and nature of capital investments that must be made in each facility

### PRELIMINARY PLANNING LAYOUT

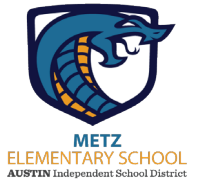

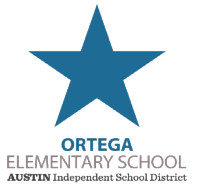
