- # of High Opportunity Schools it serves

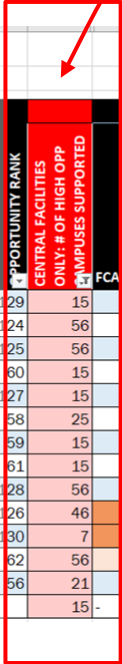
