

# **Educational Suitability Summary Report**

**Barrington Elementary School** 

Date: 01/14/2021 Score 57% Average

Barrington Elementary School serves an enrollment of approximately 445 students in northeast Austin. The original campus was built in 1969, with a studio and library addition in 1999 and another stand-alone studio building added in 2010. The buildings on campus consist of approximately 80,000 square feet on 12 acres. The campus support students from pre-K to fifth grade and promotes children's intellectual, social, emotional and physical development at all levels. It also provides dual-language education and a range of other programs that support students and encourage family participation, such as ESL classes for parents.

Overall, the building at Barrington Elementary does not adequately support the students and community. The campus is disconnected and highly varied. Each building addition has a different studio layout and a wide array of amenities. The library is in Annex B and is not easily accessible to visitors nor centralized for students. There are a lot of interior courtyards in the original building, but all other outdoor spaces are in the areas surrounding the additions. Compared to the original building, the newer additions have more efficient layouts, more modern technology and better access to natural lighting than the original building. Despite being in separate buildings, the large common spaces like the gym, library and cafeteria cannot be secured from the rest of the campus for afterhours functions. The gym and cafeteria are small, outdated and disconnected from the rest of the campus.

#### **Interview Overview**

The interview participants consisted of Principal Gilma Sanchez, Assistant Principal Nayane Olivas, behavior specialist David Otero-Lopez and counselor Sarai Vazquez Hernandez. The area of the campus that the staff would like to remain intact is the outdoor garden. They have invested many hours into developing the garden, and it is a source of pride for the school.

Many spaces are too small to meet the needs of the occupants. The gym and cafeteria cannot accommodate larger gatherings, which limits the school's ability to host the programs they desire. Another effect of the undersized campus is that many times staff have to share spaces, which results in classes needing the same space at the same time and having to find alternate spaces. The music room and art room are not equipped for efficient teaching and learning. If these spaces were improved and/or reorganized or if new spaces were added, the school would like to host a YMCA program, food bank events and extracurricular programs such as dance and soccer.

When thinking about teaching and learning 20 years from now, the school would like to focus on technology, innovation, outdoor learning, creativity and collaboration. Learning spaces and furniture will need to support technology-based learning. They would like dedicated spaces for innovative and creative teaching and learning, both inside and out. The interviewees brought up the Thinkery as an example for these types of spaces. Flexible spaces and furniture would help accommodate their

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collaborative learning needs. The school has been successful in cultivating connections between staff and parents as well as between staff members through a mentoring program. Having a dedicated welcome center and/or a large meeting room would help strengthen these collaborations. School culture is strong; however, improvements to display capabilities could strengthen it even further.

### **Assessment Findings**

The Educational Suitability Assessment of Barrington Elementary School earned a 57% overall score and places the campus in a category of Average. The assessment consists of seven General Building categories and seven Academic categories to determine areas that need more attention.

### **Unsatisfactory Categories (36-50%):**

#### **General Building**

Score is unsatisfactory.

General appearance of the school is aged. Most primary circulation is generous, but the ceilings are low and there is little natural light throughout. There are no spaces that can be securely accessed without full school access.

### **Academics & Learning**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Newer additions are more adequately sized, but original building studios are undersized. Original building has neighborhoods for studio groupings, but extra doors and levels of separation may limit informal interaction. Annex B has no neighborhood or flex spaces. Annex D has one central neighborhood for all studios.

#### **Visual and Performing Arts**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Music studio is undersized, lacks storage, restroom and small group room but is near the performance stage. The stage at the cafeteria is small and not ADA accessible. The art studio lacks storage and appears to be in a typical studio not intended for art.

#### **PE and Wellness**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Gym is undersized and needs new flooring. It lacks storage and shares restrooms with the cafeteria. There is an operable wall between the gym and cafeteria spaces.

#### **Food Services**

Score is unsatisfactory.

Cafeteria and kitchen are undersized and aged. There is an extremely small projection screen and only one option for seating. No available access to outdoors.

#### Average Categories (51-65%):

#### **Exterior**

Score is average.

The entry is easily identifiable, but the signage is difficult to read. The bus and car drop-off loops

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have no canopies for shade or rain coverage and are small, so traffic backs up onto the street.

#### Security

Score is average.

### Furniture, Fixtures, Equipment

Score is average.

Furniture is very dated throughout the school and mostly the same in common areas. The library has multiple furniture options. Larger tables are more difficult to move and not all studios have individual student desks.

### **Media Resources**

Score is average.

The library is in an addition and not well-connected to the rest of the school. It consists of one large space with no dedicated areas or zones for quiet study. The furniture is mobile for easy reconfiguration and layout could be changed to support smaller groups.

#### **Technology**

Score is average.

Some studios have projection and mobile displays; others only have one display option. Newer additions have more power and data outlets than the original building. There is a large projection screen in the gym and a small one in the cafeteria. Charging carts are provided at common spaces or in learning neighborhoods.

### Satisfactory Categories (66-80%):

#### **Outdoor Learning and Activity**

Score is satisfactory.

There are several small areas for outdoor learning in enclosed courtyards, but they do not appear to be utilized for outdoor learning. There is a small cistern at the new building.

#### **Environmental Quality**

Score is satisfactory.

Newer additions with shared restrooms have limited acoustic privacy but original building studios are separated. Original building studios have single narrow window; new additions have more access to daylight.

#### Controllability of Systems

Score is satisfactory.

Original and new buildings have a variety of lighting controls with two to three switches present for zones of light. Blinds are provided and most appear to be in good condition.

### **Administration Spaces**

Score is satisfactory.

The administration suite is in good condition and is very welcoming. Only the principal, assistant principal and nurse have offices in the main admin area; counselor and others have a separate suite. There is a large conference room at the front entry in the counselor's suite.



Main entry area is spacious and feels welcoming with displays and planters. The main entry does not have a secure vestibule and is far from reception at the end of the lobby.



Playgrounds are in good shape and have some shade from trees. Playground are easily accessible to the public being adjacent to Barrington School Park.



Cafeteria: The stage is undersized. The space feels outdated and has no access to natural light.



There are nice interior courtyards, but they do not seem to be utilized for outdoor learning. This could be an outcome of COVID-19 protocols and may not reflect a normal school year.
